3 AWESOME TOOLS USED BY OUR EXPERTS

JIM'S FAVORITE TOOL: **TAPPING BIT**

- The bit has a 90-degree tip for fast starts that eliminates the drill walking on the surface of the tree
- The short drill bit design helps reduce breakage
- The shank of the bit has three flat surfaces to ensure the drill chuck secures the drill bit
- The bit has a very tight flute pitch to quickly eject the chips and sawdust from the taphole
- The sharp flute design ensures a clean-cut taphole



KELLEN'S FAVORITE TOOL: **5/16 ROPE TOOL**

We use this a lot in the woods when we're repairing or adding lines.



GREGG'S FAVORITE TOOL: NIKON 550 FORESTRY PRO

It makes mapping in the woods so much easier, by showing distance and elevation!
